Ministry of Education Child Care Quality Assurance and Licensing General Comments and Recommendations

The document entitled "Operational Guidance During COVID-19 Outbreak: Child Care Re-Opening" sets out that all adults in a child care setting (i.e. child care staff and students) are required to wear medical masks and eye protection (i.e. face shield or goggles) and that children in grades 1 and above are required to wear a non-medical or face covering while inside the child care premises, including in hallways. All adults in a child care setting are required to wear medical masks outdoors when a distance of 2 metres cannot be maintained. All children in grades 1 and above are required to wear a non-medical mask or face covering outdoors when a distance of 2 metres cannot be maintained, while children younger than grade 1 are encouraged to wear a non-medical mask or face covering. Licensees must follow the advice of the local public health unit, even in the event that it is different from the operational guidance document.
