Our Kindergarten and School Age groups enjoyed special in-house experiences as well, including a mini golf activity and an exciting magic show right here at Childspace Centre 2!

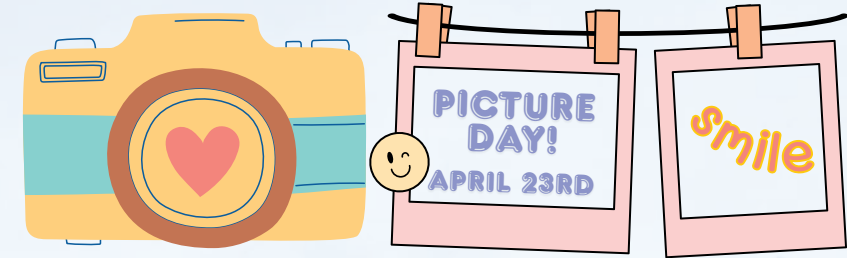
Reminders:

Please remember that according to the new **safe arrival and dismissal policy**, families are required to notify the Centre when your child will be late or absent, or when there are any changes to the child's daily pick up.

Please ensure that you are dropping your child off directly to their program. We ask that you do not allow your child to buzz in and walk up the stairs alone.

The **late pickup fee is \$1 per minute** for the first time a parent is late and **\$3 per minute** if that parent is late again within a 30-day period. Failure to pay late fees can result in withdrawal from the Centre.
